**NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL FROM WESTCHESTER INDUSTRIAL COMPLEX, LLC**


Dear Mr. Cartalemi:

Please accept this letter as a formal notice that I am exercising my right to withdraw as a twenty percent (20%) owner of Westchester Industrial Complex, LLC ("WIC"), in accordance with New York Limited Liability Company Law former §606, applicable to limited liability companies formed prior to the 1999 amendments to the statute, as referenced and confirmed in *Chiu v. Chiu*, 2015 NY Slip Op 01427 (2<sup>nd</sup> Dept. 2015) and *Garcia v. Garcia*, 33 Misc.3d 1237(A) (Kings Co. Supreme 2011).

Kindly advise if you consent to my withdrawal. If you do consent, we must discuss the fair value of my interest in WIC, in accordance with New York Limited Liability Company Law §509, and make arrangements for payment. If you do not consent, this letter shall constitute a demand that you notice and schedule a meeting with the remaining member of WIC for the purposes of voting on my withdrawal from WIC, and that such meeting be held, in accordance with Article 4 of the WIC Operating Agreement, but no later than sixty (60) days from April 1, 2015.

In the event my withdrawal from WIC is not approved, or if you fail to conduct a meeting for that purpose within sixty (60) days from April 1, 2015, then this letter is my formal notice that such withdrawal will be automatically effective on December 1, 2015. At that time, proceedings will be commenced to determine the fair value of my interest in WIC, and to secure all of my legal remedies with respect thereto, including, but not limited to, enforcement of my economic claims and for dissolution of WIC to the extent applicable.
