

Where a person has obtained money or property from another under such circumstances that in good conscience it should not be retained, the law imposes a duty to repay or return it.

Under that principle, a business partner who pays himself and his credit card providers, out of company accounts, monies to which he is not entitled, will be required to repay the company the amounts wrongfully taken.

The parties agree that during the years 2010 – 2013, more than \$234,000. in checks were issued from the company account to Defendant in excess of the checks issued to Plaintiff.

Plaintiff claims that those amounts were wrongfully taken in violation of the parties' Agreement(s) and should be returned to the company.

Defendant denies that the monies were wrongfully taken and alleges that an equal amount was paid by him in cash from the company to the individual Plaintiff by delivery to third parties on Plaintiff's behalf in 2010 – 2013.

Plaintiff claims that more than \$69,000. was wrongfully paid from the company accounts to American Express and Citicards, Defendant's personal credit card providers, during the years 2012 – 2016, and should be repaid to the company.
